



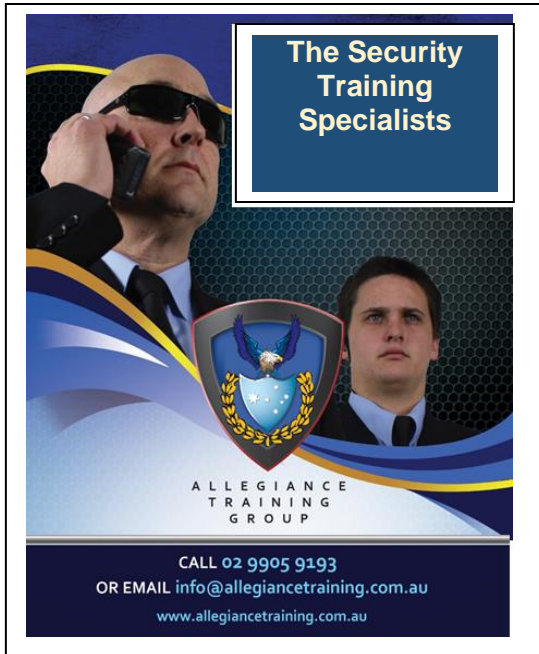

THE ENROLMENT PROCESSES

You will need to complete an enrolment form followed by a basic Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LL&N) assessment which takes place at our office. To book in for a Literacy and Numeracy assessment you will be required to pay a non-refundable deposit of \$150. Training will commence after the payment arrangement has been confirmed. This assessment is mandatory and ensures that you have the essential language skills to complete the security training course. **You are required to provide 100 points of ID to enroll in this course.** You will also be requested to read the Fact sheet 6 - "Am I Eligible for a NSW Security License" and sign the P1016 Form - "Acknowledgement of Fact sheet 6" (Grounds for refusing or revoking a Class 1 or Class 2 License).

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER

All students undertaking any training in Australia, under Federal Government requirements, are to provide a unique student identifier USI. The USI is linked to the National Vocational Education and Training (VET) Data Collection, and this means an individual's nationally recognised training and qualifications gained anywhere in Australia, from different training organisations. SLED MANDATED LANGUAGE, LITERACY AND NUMERACY ASSESSMENT (FOR CERTIFICATE II ENTRY)

It is a prerequisite that requirement all applicants to this course must compete a language, literacy and numeracy assessment, before commencing the course. The purpose of this is to address two important issues –

1. The applicant has sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to undertake the course and once completed the course to act as a security officer in the field.
2. That our training organisation can identify if the applicant has the need for any additional training by identifying significant gaps in their language, literacy and numeracy or identifying if they have sufficient prior experience or current experience to undertake an accelerated learning pathway.

After you complete the language, literacy and numeracy assessment you will be provided with feedback from your trainer/assessor and the recommendation of most suitable pathway open to you.

At the commencement of the course if you have a current statement of attainment in HLTAID011 Provide First Aid, please present a copy of the statement to the trainer. If you have not undertaken this training within the past 3 years, you will be required to have attained a statement of attainment in HLTAID011 Provide First Aid. It will be mandatory

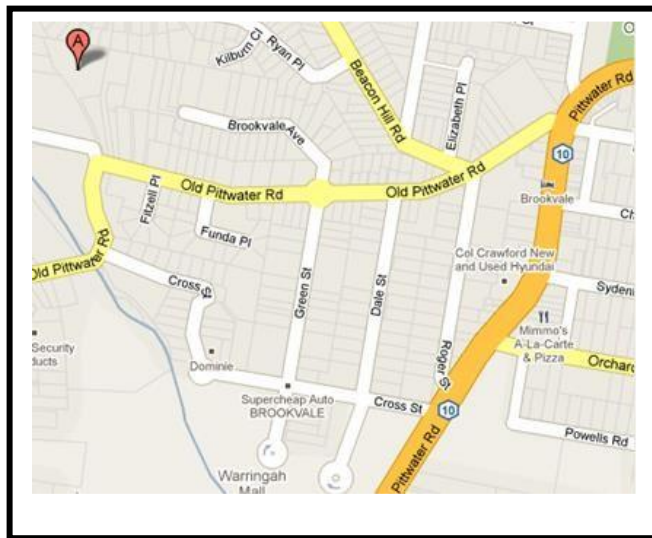
